PARENT PORTAL ACCESS

The Parent Portal is an Internet based program which allows families to electronically access some of their child's educational records, including student schedules, grades, attendance and discipline. It's available 24/7 with no restrictions on how often it is accessed. The Portal also allows families to check other personal information that is on record at the school to ensure the district has the most current information in case of an emergency. ANNUAL CHILD FIND MESSAGE FROM THE SPECIAL EDUCATION OFFICE

(Adapted from District Policy 4321 and 4321.2)

The Board of Education of the Chatham Central School District is committed to providing all students, including those with disabilities, a free appropriate education in the least restrictive environment.

The Committee on Special Education (CSE) will identify, evaluate, and recommend placement of students with disabilities who are in need of special services or programs.

The Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) is responsible for evaluation, recommendation and provision of special education programs and services for preschool students, ages 3-5, with a disability.

District residents with questions about CSE or CPSE programs may call the Director of Special Education at 392-2417.

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

If you suspect that your child may have a physical, cognitive, or emotional disability, you have the right to refer your child to the District's Committee on Special Education for an evaluation and a determination as to whether or not your child is eligible to receive special education services and programs. WORKING PAPERS

Working papers are available in the main office at the Middle School year-round (392-1560 ext. 2001), or in the nurse's office at the High School during the school year (392-4142 ext. 1006), or the High School main office (392-4142 ext. 1003) during the summer. Working papers may be obtained from 7:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. during the school year and from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. in the summer.

TRANSPORTATION TO CHILDCARE LOCATIONS & PRIVATE SCHOOLS

If you are requesting transportation to and/or from a childcare provider, or if your child will be attending a private school, you must complete a Transportation Request Form each school year, even if your childcare or private school arrangements have not changed. Requests must be completed and returned to the following offices by April 1st in the school year prior to the need for transportation.

- Childcare Transportation Requests: Superintendent's Office, 392-1501
- Private School Transportation Requests: Transportation Office, 392-2415

MANDATORY IMMUNIZATION

Prior to entering school, children must be fully immunized. Documentation of immunization is required. For more information, call the health office in your child's school building or go to the school website, choose your child's building, and click on the health office webpage.

SMOKING

The Board of Education has a policy declaring Chatham Central School District a tobacco-free environment. The use and possession of tobacco products by students is prohibited on all school properties and school sponsored events. The use of tobacco products by staff, parents or visitors is prohibited at all times within the school buildings or on school property.

WEAPONS

Possession or use of weapons by any person in or on school property or at a school function is strictly prohibited, except in the case of law enforcement officers or as specifically authorized by the District. Weapon means a firearm as defined in 18 USC S921 for purposes of the Gun-Free Schools Act. It also means a BB gun, knife, pocketknife, pepper spray or any other device, instrument, material, or substance that can cause physical injury or death when used to cause physical injury or death.

Request for Pesticide Application Notification

Dear Parents and Guardians:

The Chatham Central School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notice of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are *not* subject to prior notification requirements:

- anti-microbial products
- nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper-resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children
- silica gel and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children
- boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate
- the application of EPA-designated biopesticides
- the application of EPA-designated exempt materials under 40 CFR §152.25
- the use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets

In addition, there will be no written notice of such application when a school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72 hours following an application.

Notification of Rights – Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) – Confidentiality of Educational Records

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords parents and students over 18 years of age (“eligible students”) certain rights with respect to the student’s education records. The District shall provide annual public notice to parents and eligible students (over 18 years of age) of their rights to:

- Access and confidentiality of the student’s educational records;
- Seek amendment of the student’s educational record that they believe to be inaccurate, misleading or otherwise in violation of the student’s privacy rights and the procedures for requesting such an amendment;
- Consent to disclosure of personally identifiable information contained in the student educational record;
- Request that the District not disclose the student’s directory information, as defined herein; and
- Obtain a copy of this policy.

Such notice shall also advise parents and eligible students of the Board’s policy to disclose educational records to school officials with legitimate educational interests. For the purpose of this policy, such individuals shall include: a person employed by the District as an administrator, supervisor, teacher, instructor, or support staff member (including health or medical staff); a member of the Board of Education; a person with whom the District has contracted to perform a special task related to the student’s educational program, (medical or instructional consultant, or therapist); or a person assisting another school official in performing his or her official duties.

For the purpose of this policy the term “directory information” includes the following: the student’s name, address and phone number, email address, date and place of birth, major field of study, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, awards received, student grade level, and the most recent previous educational agency or institution attended by the student. The policy applies equally to military recruiters, the media, colleges and universities, and prospective employers, approved District booster organizations unless the family has notified the District that directory information is not be released without prior written consent. Such notice shall be provided in the parent’s dominant language or other mode of communication, wherever possible.

Parental rights under this policy shall be extended to both parents unless such rights have been specifically revoked by a court order, statute or other legally binding document.

SEXUAL HARASSMENT POLICY SUMMARY

Harassment of students and staff on the basis of sex or sexual orientation is:

- abusive and illegal behavior
- behavior that harms victims and negatively impacts the school culture
- behavior that creates an environment of fear, distrust, intimidation and intolerance

The Chatham Board of Education:

- is committed to providing an educational and working environment that promotes respect, dignity and equality and that is free from all forms of sexual harassment
- condemns and strictly prohibits all forms of sexual harassment on school grounds, school buses and at all school-sponsored activities, programs and events including those that take place at locations outside the District

It shall be a violation of the District's Sexual Harassment Policy for any student, staff member or third party (school visitor, vendor, etc.) to sexually harass any student, staff member or third party.

It is essential that all victims of sexual harassment and persons with knowledge of sexual harassment **report the harassment immediately**. The District will promptly investigate ALL complaints of sexual harassment.

If, after appropriate investigation, the District finds that a student, a staff member or a third party has violated this policy, prompt corrective action will be taken in accordance with the applicable collective bargaining agreement, District policy and state law.

All complainants and those who participate in the investigation of a com-

plaint of sexual harassment have the right to be free from retaliation of any kind.

The information here is an excerpt from the Board of Education policy that was adopted in July, 2003. If you would like to see the full policy and detailed Sexual Harassment Regulations, please ask in any building office or the Superintendent's Office.

DIGNITY FOR ALL STUDENTS ACT (DASA) – INFORMATION ABOUT BULLYING

Bullying of a student by another student is strictly prohibited on school property, school buildings, school buses, and at school sponsored events or activities occurring on or off campus. The District also prohibits "Internet bullying" (also referred to as "cyberbullying") including the use of instant messaging, emails, websites, chat rooms, and text messaging when such use interferes with the operation of the school; or infringes upon the general safety and welfare of others.

Any student who believes that he/she is being subjected to bullying behavior, as well as any other person who has knowl-

edge of or witnesses any possible occurrence of bullying, is urged to report the bullying to any staff member, the building principal, or one of the DASA coordinators listed below. Bullying allegations will be treated as confidential and private to the extent possible within legal constraints.

ADDITIONAL STUDENT PRIVACY INFORMATION

Videotapes, digital movies and/or photographs of students may be shared with the public through, for example, public media outlets, the District newsletters, reports, website and other District communications, or those of our educational partners, unless the parent/guardian or eligible student requests, in writing, that videotapes, digital movies or photographs of the student not be publicized.

The District also often shares examples of works produced by our students, such as writing, artwork, photographs of students, videos, coding, and music, through public media outlets and through District newsletters, reports, website, social media sites, and other District communications or those of our educational partners. If you do not wish to have your child's work publicized/reproduced, a parent/guardian or eligible student should request, in writing, that the student's work not be publicized/reproduced by the District.

Parents or eligible students (age 18 or older) have a right to request that such information NOT be released by the school. It is the responsibility of the parent or student to make these wishes known, in writing, to the building principal or superintendent by September 21, 2016 or within 15 days of student's enrollment in school.
